



## Report of the General Assembly of CPGS Yaoundé in Cameroon from the 24th to the 25th of June 2022

From Friday 24<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2022 at CICM of Mvolyé in Yaoundé, Cameroon took place the general assembly of the council of Protestants in guiding and scouting (CPGS). Convened to this general assembly as stipulated by the status of CPGS:

- The outgoing members of CPGS committee,
- Regular members of CPGS,
- associate members of CPGS,
- observer members.

Initially programmed for 2021, the General Assembly was postponed due to travel restrictions imposed by the Covid-19 Pandemic

It finally took place from the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> of June 2022 in Cameroon and in Yaoundé at the CICM Mvolyé, in accordance with the resolution of the General Assembly of Paris in 2018 and presided over by **Dr. Charles-Olivier YAPI, Interim President**

After verifications of the different procedures of the validity of the General Assembly:

- That the legal minimum of members to attend were present. In effect out of the eight ex-officio members, five were present, three physically (Côte d'Ivoire with 02 ex-officio members, Cameroon) and two through zoom ( France et Germany)
  - **Les Scouts du Cameroun (Cameroon)**
  - **Éclaireuses et Éclaireurs Unionistes de Côte d'Ivoire (EEUCI) (Côte d'Ivoire)**
  - **Éclaireuses et Éclaireurs de Côte d'Ivoire (EEDCI) (Associate members) (Côte d'Ivoire)**
  - **Eclaireuses et Eclaireurs Unionistes de France (EEUdF) (France)**
  - **Verband Christlicher Pfadfinderinnen und Pfadfinder (VCP) (Germany)**
- Given that the ex-officio members were not up to date with their contribution;

And so members present decided:

- Not to go in for elections of the committee of CPGS due to this default of contributions in accordance with article 3 of the statutes of CPGS of 2006;

- To appoint Mr. Serge Georges BADJI as Chair Person of the General Assembly;
- To continue with the works of the General Assembly;
- Endorse the resignation of the President Annette Von Stockhausen;
- To confirm Dr. YAPI Charles Olivier as Interim President with responsibility of representing CPGS at all levels of Scouting and Guiding;
- To continue works on editing the texts and reinvigorate CPGS;

After all these decisions, the Interim President paid a vibrant homage to Annette Von Stockhausen for launching this organization and most especially for wanting to restore and relinquish the protestant family in world scouting and guiding.

Later those present focused on the two days in drafting the road map and resolutions.

During the discussions, the assembly in its majority adopted the following resolutions and roadmap:

## RESOLUTIONS

- Mindful of the Statutes of CPGS of 2006;
- Mindful of the resignation of the President Annette VON STOCKHAUSEN on the 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2022, rendered public on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June 2022;
- Mindful of the statutory Interim assumed by the Vice President Charles-Olivier YAPI since the 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2022;
- Mindful of the demands of the following associations:
  - Fédération des Scouts de la République Démocratique du Congo (DRC) – Observer,
  - Escuteiros da Guiné-Bissau (Guinea-Bissau) – Regular Member,
  - União dos Escoteiros Brasil (Brazil) – Observer,
  - Tily Eto Madagasikara, Firaisan’ny Skotisma Eto Madagasikara (Madagascar)– Observer,
  - Association Nationale des Scouts de Guinée (Guinea) – Regular Member,
  - Scoutisme Béninois (Benin) - Regular Member,
  - Association des Eclaireurs Unionistes du Gabon (Gabon) – Regular Member,
  - Association Eclaireuses et Eclaireurs Evangéliques de Côte d’Ivoire - Regular Member,
  - Eclaireuses et Eclaireurs Unionistes de Centrafrique – Observer.
- Mindful of irregularities in contribution of members;
- Mindful of the absence of some statutory members;
- Delegates of the General Assembly of Yaoundé of the 24<sup>th</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> June 2022:
- Approved :
  - The extension of the Interim mandate of the World Committee of 2018 to 2022 until the next elective General Assembly proposed for the month of November 2023;
  - That the World Committee takes as responsibility of putting in place the roadmap decided upon during the General Assembly of Yaoundé 2022;

- That the World Committee recovers the contributions.
- That the Committee sends an online request for candidacies to host the next ordinary General Assembly schedule for November 2023.
