Arrangements for entering Cameroon:

- Participants coming from a country which has an Embassy or Consulate: Go to the Consulate with the valid Passport, the invitation letter and the Flight Plan. Pay the Visa fees required by the Consulate of the country.

- Participants coming from a country that does not have an Embassy or Consulate: Possibility of obtaining a Visa on arrival at the borders; the cost of the entry visa to Cameroon is 50,000 XAF. Transmit at least 20 days before arrival the first page of the passport and the flight plan for the facilitation and speed in obtaining the Visa to the CPGS by email to cpgs@vcp.de or to the CPGS representative in Cameroon at likabinathaniel@gmail.com.

N.B.: The passport must be valid for at least six months.



Sanitary provisions:

- International vaccination record: up to date with the required Yellow Fever vaccine.
- COVID-19 :
 - Each country has regulations for the fight against COVID 19 and safety in international travel (COVID 19 test certificate); thank you for complying.
 - A PCR test is required upon arrival at the Airports at a cost of 30,000 XAF.
