Dear Friends in Scouting!

The agenda of the CPGS General Assembly in Yaoundé will focus on 03 major determining points in the Vision and governance of CPGS for the 2022-2025 triennium.

Those are :

1. The renewal of the CPGS Statutes,

This point will revisit the current statutes resulting from the General Assembly of October 13 to 14, 2006 in Copenhagen in order to provide the CPGS with dynamic and factual statutes in accordance with good governance principles. We propose the draft statutes attached for your comments before adoption at the General Assembly.

2. The 2022-2025 Three-Year Action Plan

The objective of the Plan is to plan and present the strategies put forward by the Committee in terms of the development of activities for young people and the development of the organization. A Three-Year Plan draft in the appendix is proposed to you for your comments before adoption at the General Assembly in Yaoundé.

3. Election and re-election of the CPGS Committee (President, Vice-President, Treasurer, 2 additional members)

This point follows the tradition of good governance of any organization. The current Committee of 05 members records 03 departures, therefore three voting members are to be elected and 02 voting members are to be re-elected for the next General Assembly. Under no circumstances may more than one elected member from the same Member Organization sit simultaneously on the Committee. In addition, the new statutes that will be adopted will allow the new Committee to designate the new World Chaplain of the CPGS after analyzing the applications received.
